

15. **FAMILY** (Ephesians 5:25-28, 6:4; 1 Peter 3:7)

- Am I sensitive and do I respond to the needs of my spouse?
- Am I imparting Godly, eternal values

16. **CLEAR CONSCIENCE** (Matthew 18:15-22; Acts 24:16)

- Am I harboring resentment, unforgiveness or bitterness toward anyone?
- Am I willing to release offenses and be reconciled to God and the person with whom I am offended?

17. **FORGIVENESS** (Matthew 6:12; Colossians 3:12-14)

- Am I quick to forgive?
- Do I seek to resolve relational conflicts as soon as possible?

18. **EVANGELISM** (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8)

- Do I have a burden for the lost?
- Am I reaching out to the lost with the Good News of salvation in Christ?
- Am I discipling anyone in the faith?

Which area do I need to focus on in prayer? Remember, without the empowering of the Holy Spirit, I cannot do this.



ACTION STEPS FOR PERSONAL REVIVAL

Mentoring God's People in Integrity & Spiritual Maturity

On the eve of their passage through the Jordan River and into Canaan, the land of Promise, Joshua commanded Israel to prepare their hearts, "Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the LORD will do amazing things among you." (Joshua 3:5)

Whenever God is about to do a great thing there is always a need for personal cleansing. The following areas are not intended to bring condemnation (Romans 8:1) but to help guide us through this process. Here's the plan...

- Pray the prayer of David in Psalm 139:23-24 *Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.*
- Be honest. Ask God to open your heart and reveal hidden issues as you read through the issues in this brochure.
- Confess each short-coming, with the willingness to make it right and to forsake it. Remember, it's His Power that enables us!
- Praise God for His forgiveness and His continuing intervention in your life.
- Review these points periodically to remain sensitive to the Holy Spirit and the need for ongoing revival.

PRAYER Heavenly Father, I realize that even though I have confessed You as my personal Savior and Lord, my life may not reflect the full surrender of a disciple. I ask Your forgiveness for living by my own standards. Ignite in me a passion for You and the things You value. Empower me by Your Holy Spirit to accomplish this. Amen.

1. **GENUINE SALVATION** (John 3:3; Romans 10:9-10; 2 Corinthians 5:17)
 - Was there a time when I genuinely repented and forsook my sins?
 - Was there a time when I completely surrendered my heart and my life to Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord?
2. **GOD'S WORD** (Psalm 119)
 - Do I love to read and meditate on God's Word?
 - Do I apply what I read to everyday life?
3. **HOLY SPIRIT CONTROL** (Galatians 5:22-25; Ephesians 5:18-21)
 - Am I allowing the Holy Spirit to lead and control my life?
 - Is there consistent evidence of the fruit of the Spirit?
4. **SENSITIVITY** (Matthew 5:23-24)
 - Am I sensitive to the prompting of the Holy Spirit?
 - Do I quickly respond to the Holy Spirit's prompting?
5. **MY "FIRST LOVE"** (Philippians 1:21-23; Revelation 2:4-5)
 - Am I as much in love with Jesus as I was when I first believed?
 - Is He the center and most important Person in my life?
6. **PRAYER** (Matthew 6:9-13; 1 Timothy 2:1-2)
 - Am I faithful to a consistent life of prayer?
 - Is my prayer life filled with joy and intimacy with the Father?
 - Do I specifically and fervently pray for renewal in my own life, in members of my family, in my church, in my city, state and nation?
7. **OBEDIENCE** (1 Samuel 15:22; Hebrews 13:17)
 - Do I consistently obey God?
 - Do I (inwardly and outwardly) obey my human authorities

- that God has placed over my life?
8. **SACRIFICE** (Proverbs 11:25; Philippians 3:7-8;)
 - Am I willing to sacrifice whatever it may take to see a move of the Spirit of God in my life and in the church?
 - Am I a giving person?
 9. **HUMILITY** (Isaiah 57:15)
 - Am I quick to admit I am wrong?
 - Do I rejoice when others receive praise when I my go unnoticed for my accomplishments?
 10. **A PURE HEART** (Matthew 5:8; 1 John 1:9)
 - Do I keep "short accounts" with God?
 - Do I consistently search my heart for hidden issues that may be displeasing with God?
 11. **MORAL PURITY** (Ephesians 5:3-5)
 - Do I aggressively keep my mind and my spirit free from input that stimulates immoral fantasizing?
 - Is my lifestyle pure and above reproach (not able to be accused)?
 12. **MOTIVES** (Matthew 10:28; Ephesians 6:5-8; James 4:3)
 - Am I more concerned with how God thinks of me than what others think?
 - Do I love and serve unconditionally?
 13. **VALUES** (Psalm 97:10; Proverbs 6:16-19)
 - Do I love what God loves and hate what God hates?
 - Are my affections fixed on eternal values?
 14. **PRIORITIES** (Matthew 6:31-33)
 - Does my schedule, checkbook, etc. reveal that God is first in my life?
 - Are important relationships in life more important than tasks, success, etc.?
