



**Peace comes when you destroy the authority that causes chaos.**

Judges 6:24 So *Gideon built an altar to the Lord there and called it The Lord Is Peace.*

Genesis 3:15 *“And I will put enmity (open hostility) between you and the woman, and between your seed (offspring) and her Seed; He shall (fatally) bruise your head, and you shall (only) bruise His heel.”*

Judges 6:24 So *Gideon built an altar to the Lord there and called it The Lord Is Peace.*

Colossians 2:13-15 *...And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.*

Ephesians 2:14-16 *For He Himself is our peace,... having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.*

The Hebrew word for peace is “Shalom,” and the characters are read from right to left. When placed together the meaning is surprising and states that peace comes when you destroy (Sheen) the authority (Lamed) that causes (Vav) chaos (Mem).



**Sheen**

To destroy, something sharp, teeth, to devour, to consume.



**Lamed**

Authority, to control, a cattle goad, tongue (the rod that devours or establishes life).



**Vav**

A hook or a nail joining together, making secure, bound to.



**Mem**

Chaos like the ocean, mighty, massive or many, to come from (like water down a stream)

*Peace comes when you destroy the authority that causes (is bound to) chaos.*
