**1. Seasons change slowly, but they DO change.**

- Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 *To everything there is a season, a time for every purpose under heaven:...*
- Seasons change... **but God remains the same!** (Malachi 3:6; Hebrews 13:8)

**2. What worked (or was familiar) in the last season may no longer work in the new season of life.**

- Matthew 9:16-7 *...Nor do they put new wine into old wineskins, or else the wineskins break (burst), the wine is spilled, and the wineskins are ruined. But they put new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved.*
- Joshua 1:1-9 — Israel coming out of a 40 year season wandering in the wilderness faced intense changes and an entirely new life. Even though the wilderness years were the result of God's judgement, they were completely taken care of. Now they faced the challenge of conquering and possessing the Promised Land and then, instead of the provision of Manna, they had to learn new skills.
- In verses 16-17 we see that Israel's attitude towards the new season was very positive

**3. Seasons always build upon the previous ones.**

- The sowing and reaping principle from Galatians 6:7-8... we reap what we've sown, we reap in another season, and we reap in multitudes.
- Sow to the Spirit by living your life with an Eternal focus. Abraham's eternal

focus in Hebrews 11:9-10 *By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise; for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God.* (“Waited” means to accept from another Source, to expect, wait for)

**4. For the Believer whose trust is in the Lord, new seasons bring greater blessing, power, and fruitfulness.**

- Matthew 27:27-56 (The Crucifixion); Acts 2:1-4, 40-47 (The outpouring of the Holy Spirit)

**Lord Jesus**, as you open before us new seasons in life, fill us with a renewed empowerment of faith and vision. Change fear to faith, turn sorrow into joy, and despair into hope. Let Your Kingdom of righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit come to us on earth as it is in Heaven, and lead us into Your glorious purpose.
