

"IF THE SPIRIT WHO RAISED Christ FROM THE DEAD LIVES IN YOU..."
Romans 8:11

John 11:25-26 *Jesus said to (Martha), "I AM the Resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"*

Romans 8:11 *And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you (Oikeo, to live in you as you live in your house, remains in you, to cohabit), He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life (zoopieo, give life, make alive, quicken) to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you.*

1. Romans 8:11 is true if...

- A. Christ was raised from the dead — 1 Corinthians 15 ...*But now, as things really are, Christ has in fact been raised from the dead. He has become the first to be resurrected with an incorruptible, immortal body, foreshadowing the resurrection of those who have preceded us in death.*
- B. His Spirit is living in you — Acts 2:38 *38 Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.*
 - Jesus breathed on the disciples when He appeared to them after His Resurrection. (John 20:22-23)
 - Jesus gave us the promise of the outpouring of the Spirit in Acts 1:8 *You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you.* (Luke 11:13; Ephesians 5:18-21)

2. The results of the Spirit's life in you...

Christ's earthly works through the power of the Holy Spirit — Acts 10:38 *How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.*

- A. The Holy Spirit strengthens and roots us in Christ. (1 Corinthians 14:4; Ephesians 3:16-19)
- B. Greater is He (the Holy Spirit) who is in us than the prince of this world! (John 16:33; 1 John 4:4)
 - Spend time to listen to the One IN you rather than the one in the world!
- C. Through the Spirit we have power over all emotional and demonic turmoil. (2 Timothy 1:7)
- D. Through the Resurrection we have the assurance of Eternal Life. (1 Peter 1:3-5)
- E. As we walk after/with the Holy Spirit we bear the fruit of God's Character. (Galatians 5:16-18, 22-25)
- F. The Holy Spirit empowers believers for greater works and greater levels of prayer. (1 Corinthians 12:1-11; Romans 8:26-27)
- G. The Holy Spirit and transforms us into His image. (2 Corinthians 3:17-18; Romans 12:1-2; 1 John 3:2-3)
- H. The Holy Spirit guides and leads us in all things. (John 16:13; Romans 8:14)
- I. When we use the language of the Spirit (tongues), we build ourselves up. Literal Greek means to build our spiritual house. (1 Corinthians 14:4)
- J. It is through the Holy Spirit that the Good News of God's love is spread around the world — Acts 1:8 *...and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.*
