WHY PRAY THE DISCIPLES' PRAYER PATTERN?

Matthew 6:5-15; Luke 11:1-13

It is a prayer taught by Jesus to His followers which addresses every life issue and need.

- ***Our Father*** speaks of our relationship with God.
- ***In Heaven*** reminds us of His glorious Throne and Sovereignty.
- ***Hallowed be Your Name*** leads us to praise Him for who He is.
